## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### A. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time;
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on “Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty”.
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
10. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated during recycling or reuse or recovery or pre-processing or utilisation of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed of as per specific conditions of authorisation.
11. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
12. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.
13. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
14. Annual return shall be filed by June 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.

### B. SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. The industry shall not procure & process its raw material without obtaining authorization under Rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
2. The industry shall store its hazardous wastes generated from different manufacturing activities / otherwise, within its premises in an environmentally sound manner as per provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
3. The industry shall dispose off its hazardous waste generated in category no. 34.2 (1.5 TPA) to the Common Hazardous Waste Treatment & Disposal Facility as per provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
4. The industry shall ensure regular lifting of hazardous waste and also ensure that the quantity of hazardous waste generated per year shall not be stored beyond 90 days (extendable upto 180 days) in its premises at any time.
5. The industry shall ensure the compliance of stipulations imposed at the time of allotment of plot and / or thereafter by the PSIEC.
6. The empty barrels / containers / liners contaminated with hazardous wastes / chemicals procured (not more than 100 nos./day) as per this authorization shall not be traded or transferred to any trader / other party / other industry. The said contaminated containers / liners / barrels shall be utilized only by the industry in its own premises or disposed (whenever situation arises) only at authorized facility as authorized by Punjab Pollution Control Board.
7. The industry shall ensure that the contaminated containers / liners / barrels are procured from the industrial units, who have valid authorization for the same from the concerned State Pollution Control Board as required under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
8. During the process of utilization and handling of contaminated containers / liners / barrels, the industry shall comply with the requirements in accordance with the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 as amended, wherever applicable.
9. The industry shall ensure the standard operating procedure (SoP) prepared by the Central Pollution Control Board for utilization of hazardous waste category no. 33.1 (empty barrels / containers / liners contaminated with hazardous wastes / chemicals) and shall ensure that minimal requisite facilities for utilization of said hazardous waste are in good working condition at all times.
10. The industry shall handle the hazardous waste(s) strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board / Ministry of Environment & Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi.
11. In case the industry fails to comply with the above conditions of authorization as well as provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and/or any other environmental law applicable to the industry and Rules, Circulars & Directions issued by the Board from time to time, the Board shall constrained to take action against the industry under the provisions of the Pollution Control Laws.
